Commander, 78th Troop Command



Brig. Gen. Scott entered the Georgia Army National Guard in 1986. He commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in August 1997 after completing Officer Candidate School. He is the senior Military Intelligence Officer in the Georgia Army National Guard with a long and distinguish career of 37 years of service.

Brig. Gen. Scott has served as Regimental Commander for the 122d Regional Training Institute (RTI), the State Intelligence Officer (G2/J2), Battalion Commander of the 221st Military Intelligence Battalion and Company Commander of the 248th Military Intelligence Company. He deployed to Kosovo in 2010-2011 to serve as the G2 for NATO's Multi-National Battle Group-East. He also deployed to Iraq in 2005-2006 where he served as S2 for the 118th Field Artillery Battalion during Operation IRAQI FREEDOM.



Brig. Gen. Scott holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Georgia State University; a Master of Science in Business Management from University of Maryland Global Campus; and a Master of Science in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College.
