



CSM David L. Creamer

Command Sergeant Major, 48th Infantry Brigade Command Team



CSM David L. Creamer Currently serves as the Command Sergeant Major for the 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team and as the 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team, operations sergeant major. CSM David Creamer was born in Macon, Georgia. SGM Creamer joined the Georgia Army National Guard on June 22, 2000.

He attended basic training at Ft. Jackson, South Carolina and Advanced Individual Training at Ft. Huachuca, Arizona to become a Counter Intelligence Agent. Upon completion of AIT, CSM Creamer was assigned to Bravo Co., 221st Military Intelligence Battalion.



SGM Creamer was mobilized from February 2003 to March 2004 with the 221ST MI BN in Support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, where he served as a Human Intelligence team assistant team leader. CSM Creamer was again mobilized to Iraq with the 221st MI BN in June of 2005 to October of 2006 where he served as a Tactical HUMINT Team Leader. In 2008, MSG Creamer transferred to the 122nd Regiment Regional Training Institute, where he served as a Military Intelligence Instructor with over 1500 hours of instructional time.

In November of 2013, CSM Creamer became the S2 NCOIC for the 1-108th Cavalry and the Assistant Operations Sergeant. CSM Creamer deployed with the 2-121 IN BN to Afghanistan in December of 2014 until October 2015, where he served as the S2 for Regional Command North.

After returning from his deployment, SGM Creamer served as the S2 NCOIC for the 560th BFSB until March 2016 when he was promoted to the rank of MSG as the Senior Chief Intelligence Sargent for the 48th IBCT. In November of 2018 CSM Creamer was deployed to Afghanistan as the 3-121 IN BN, OPS SGM. During this deployment he was assigned to B Co/ 3-121 IN BN as a Rifle Company First Sergeant.

In October 2022, CSM Creamer was assigned as the first sergeant for D Co/3-121 in BN (heavy weapons). In March of 2023 CSM Creamer was promoted to be the operations Sergeant major at 78 Aviation Troop command and the first DRU BN CSM in 78 ATN history. In January of 2024 CSM Creamer was selected to be the CSM for 3-121 IN BN/ 48th IBCT.

CSM Creamer's awards include the Bronze Star Medal (2nd Award), Meritorious Service Medal (3rd Award), Army Commendation Medal (3rd Award), Army Achievement Medal (3rd Award), Good Conduct Medal, Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal (w/ 2 Bronze Stars), Afghanistan Campaign Medal (w/1 Bronze Star), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, NATO Service Ribbon, Armed Forces Reserve Medal, NCO Development Ribbon (w/ Numeral 3), Army Service Ribbon, Georgia meritorious Service Ribbon, Georgia Commendation Medal (2nd Award), Georgia Special Operations Ribbon (3rd award), Meritorious Unit Citation (with oak leaf cluster). MSG Creamer was awarded the German Armed Forces Proficiency Badge (Silver), German marksmanship badge (gold). MSG Creamer is also the recipient of the Military Intelligence Corps Knowlton Award and the Infantry Association's Order of St. Maurice.

CSM Creamer resides in Acworth, Georgia with his wife and fellow guardsman and Iraq veteran CSM Meagan Goodman and their daughters Callie (16), Julia (14) and Ruby (10).
