



Lieutenant Colonel Elijah Carroll

Commander, 4th Weapons of Mass Destruction-Civil Support Team

Lieutenant Colonel Elijah Carroll's military career began when he enlisted in the Georgia Army National Guard in March 2002. As an enlisted Soldier, he served as 19D Cavalry Scout in E Troop, 108th Cavalry in Griffin, Georgia.

LTC Carroll graduated as a member of the Corps of Cadets and commissioned as a Second Lieutenant with the Armor Branch from the University of North Georgia on 13 December 2008, earning Bachelor's in Business Administration in Management. He also holds a Masters of Science in Organizational Leadership from Argosy University.

His military education includes Advanced Operations, Command and General Staff Officer College Common Core (top 20%), Reserve Components National Security Course, Maneuver Captains Career, Armor Basic Officer Leadership (Commandant's List), Joint Firepower, Army Reconnaissance, Cavalry Leader, Human Resource Management Qualification, Combatives Level 1, Company Level Pre-Command, Advanced Situational Awareness- Basic, Foundation Instruction Facilitation, Squad Designated Marksman, Pathfinder, Air Assault, Airborne, Reconnaissance and Surveillance Leader, and the U.S. Army Ranger School.



Prior to his present assignment as the Commander of the 4th Civil Support Team (WMD), his assignment include S3 Operations Officer to the 201st Regional Support Group, Deputy Commander to 221st Expeditionary Military Intelligence Battalion, and the 1-108th Cavalry S3 and G3 Collective Training Officer. LTC Carroll has held a number of other key positions in previous assignments. He served as an Assistant Professor of Military Science, GA ARNG Liaison Officer, and GA ARNG Detachment Commander at the University of North Georgia. He served as the C TRP/ 1-108th CAV Commander (Dismounted Reconnaissance Troop), Squadron S1 in HHT/ 1-108th CAV, Plans Officer in HHT/ 1-108th CAV, Executive Officer in B TRP/ 1-108th CAV, and Platoon Leader in B TRP/ 1-108th CAV. LTC Carroll's previous overseas assignments include Platoon Designated Marksman for Operation Iraqi Freedom III in 2005, ARCENT Urban Operations Team OIC Lebanon 2011, Stalwart Guardian Canada 2014, Noble Partner Georgia 2016, Cadet Coalition Warfighter Program Team Leader Argentina 2019, and OIC for Training Management Workshop in Georgia 2021.
