MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Homeschool Group Partnership Expectations • 2026-2027

PROGRAM HOURS

Student arrival: 9:30 a.m. • Departure: 1:30 p.m. • Early drop-off is not available.

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- Program times may be modified by mutual agreement; five instructional hours per day are required for program participation.
- Participating adults and students are expected to follow the Peach State STARBASE Code of Conduct included with the student applications.

THE HOMESCHOOL GROUP WILL

- Provide transportation to and from the STARBASE facility.
- Provide lunch and drinks for each student.
- Provide one or two adults per class, each day, to serve as chaperones.
- Ensure each student submits a complete application packet, including permission and release forms and a copy of the student's birth certificate, before the first academy day.
- Provide the date of birth and affirmation of U.S. citizenship for each attending adult and driver's license information for each driver, who must be a U.S. citizen. Drivers must also provide the vehicle tag number, proof of insurance, and current registration. Submit all information at least one week before the academy begins.
- Provide supportive classroom management and discipline for participating students.

PEACH STATE STARBASE WILL

- Deliver a 25-hour curriculum aligned with Georgia STEM standards.
- Provide all personnel, materials, and equipment required for instruction.
- Arrange and/or provide access to the secured military facility, physical security for participants while on base, and emergency services.
- Provide standard comfort and sanitation facilities for students and adults.
- Capture still and video photography throughout the academy and provide approved participants access to available photographs and videos.
- Provide all program materials and services at no direct cost to the homeschool group.
