- 35K+ deployed since 9/11.
- In CY25 more than 600 Soldiers deployed as part of unit mobilizations.
- Soldiers and Airmen served on all seven continents to include Antarctica.
- Our service members supported operations around the globe (e.g., Europe, South America, the Pacific, Africa, and the Middle East).
- Conducting specialized tasks during deployment activities as a part of the Joint Force.

DOMESTIC OPERATIONS

Natural & Man-Made Disasters

- In FY26, helped secure our nation's capital, and provided additional forces along our nation's southern border.
- Supported DHS and ICE agency operations with both Army and Air personnel at federal detention centers in Georgia.
- Hurricane Helene: 1,915 Guardsmen respond for a total of 35 days to 106 mission assignments across 35 counties Supported 8 main mission types and supported 2x EMAC requests to North Carolina.
- Hurricane Ida: 358 Guardsmen responded to Louisiana with 7 mission types.
- 3,911 Guardsmen activated in response to COVID-19 with 3,503 WebEOC mission requests.
- 802 total days on mission in support of state and federal response to COVID-19.



SPECIAL PROGRAMS

State Partnership Program

- Conducted 38 engagements with our partners, Argentina and the Country of Georgia in FY25.
- Argentina engagements focused on DOMOPs, Engineering, Aerospace Medical Operations, and Aviation Operations.
- Conducted a strategic-level engagement with the Governor's Delegation, The Adjutant General, and Senior Argentine Defense Officials, reinforcing the enduring strategic partnership and expanding opportunities for future bilateral cooperation with a whole of government approach.
- Celebrated 31 years of partnership with Georgia on October 3, 2025.

Counter Drug Task Force

- Partnered with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies across GA; supported the seizure of over \$62.3M in contraband during FY26.
- FY26, assisted law enforcement with interdicting over 31.7M lethal doses of fentanyl; seized enough synthetic opioids to kill the entire population of GA twice.
- Provided education to over 9.7K at-risk youths in Georgia about the dangers of drug use.



Youth ChalleNGe Program

- 33 years of success, 22-week program developing cadets in academic excellence, physical fitness, and service to the community.
- Since July 2024, 459 cadets have graduated, 103 received their GEDs, 127 received their high school diplomas and 2,516 high school credits were awarded.
- Job ChalleNGe Academy, 120 associates graduated since July 2024 with vocational training and completed 2,887 hours in community service.

STARBASE

- October 2024, recognized as one of the first STARBASE Centers of Excellence, and awarded the highest-level certification in the STARBASE system.
- 25 hours of 5th grade STEAM Curriculum, for 1,600 students annually via community outreach programs.
- Since 2001, over 18,000 students, rated one of the top academies in the system.
