Command Sergeant Major, Georgia State Defense Force

Command Sergeant Major (Retired) Miguel “Mike” Ramos currently serves as the State Command Sergeant Major for the Georgia State Defense Force. He brings more than 29 years of combined military service, including 26 years of Active Duty service in the United States Army and over three years of continued service with the Georgia State Defense Force.

CSM(R) Ramos enlisted in the United States Army and served in numerous leadership and operational assignments throughout a distinguished military career. Early assignments included service as a Lance Missile Crewmember and Team Leader in Giessen, Germany, and Fort Sill, Oklahoma. As a senior noncommissioned officer, he served in multiple key leadership positions, including three separate First Sergeant assignments over a five-year period.



His senior leadership assignments include Command Sergeant Major (Alternate), 1st Recruiting Brigade, Fort Meade, Maryland; Battalion Command Sergeant Major, Baltimore Recruiting Battalion; and Battalion Command Sergeant Major, Jacksonville Recruiting Battalion. Throughout his career, CSM(R) Ramos was recognized for his commitment to Soldier development, organizational readiness, and mission accomplishment.

Following his retirement from Active Duty service, CSM(R) Ramos continued his dedication to leadership and public service through education administration and service within the Georgia State Defense Force. In his civilian career, he currently serves as Superintendent and Executive Director of Hapeville Charter Career Academy, a position he has held since 2020. His prior educational leadership roles include Executive Director of CCS; General Manager for Delta Career Education; Campus President for Miller-Motte College; Campus President for Rasmussen College; and Senior Director of Admissions for Rasmussen College.
